USED HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS (non-diplomatic) foreigner

Documents Required

- AWB/BL.
- Packing lists.
- Consignee's passport copy.
- Consignee's residence card.
- Pro forma invoice.
- Notarized Power of attorneys (drafts to be sent by local agent):
- 1 for transport from port when coming by sea
- 1 for local clearance

Customs Prescriptions

- Subject to payment of import duties, app. 4.00 EURO per kg.

Remarks

- The clearance for non-diplomatic shipments may take up to 10 working days. If import permissions are required, add more days depending on the kind of permissions.

USED HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS (diplomatic)

Documents Required

- AWB/BL.
- Packing lists.
- Consignee's passport copy.
- Consignee's diplomatic card.
- Pro forma invoice.
- Power of attorneys (drafts to be sent by local agent):
- 1 for transport from port when coming by sea
- 1 for local clearance

Customs Prescriptions

- Exempted from any import duties

Remarks

- The clearance for diplomatic shipments may take 1-2 days in case all required documents are provided.

USED HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS (returning citizen)

Documents Required

- AWB/BL.
- Packing lists.
- Consignee's Armenian passport copy.
- Statement of permanent residency to get duty free exemption from State Revenue
- Committee.
- Social security card
- Pro forma invoice.
- Power of attorneys (drafts to be sent by local agent):
- 1 for transport from port when coming by sea
- 1 for local clearance

Customs Prescriptions

- Returning status is granted by Committee.
- Upon arrival of the shipment, the client should collect all required documents accompanying the shipment and apply to the Committee for duty free import.
- The process may take up to app. one month and storage charges will incur.

Remarks

- The process of clearance depends how quick duty free import will be granted. Once it is confirmed the clearance may take app. one week.

USED HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS (foreigners exempted through their organization)

Documents Required

- AWB/BL.
- Packing lists.
- Consignee's passport copy.
- Consignee's residence card.
- Exemption dox/letters provided by the account only.
- Pro forma invoice.
- Power of attorneys (drafts to be sent by local agent):
- 1 for transport from port when coming by sea
- 1 for local clearance

Customs Prescriptions

- Duty free import is granted through the account/Embassy.

Remarks

- The duty free import is granted through the account/Embassy. Upon arrival of the shipment the account should get ready all required letters as per their company policy to get the exemption accordingly.

Vehicle (diplomatic/non diplomatic)

Documents Required

- BL.
- Car original title.
- Consignee's passport copy.
- Consignee's residence card/diplomatic card.

- Pro forma invoice.
- Power of attorneys (drafts to be sent by local agent):
- 1 for transport from port when coming by sea
- 1 for local clearance

Customs Prescriptions

- Diplomats are exempted but non-diplomats should pay import duties for the cars.
- The amount depends on the peculiarities of the car.
- All non-diplomatic cars are forwarded to city Gyumri which causes additional charges and is more time consuming.

Remarks

- The clearance process for diplomatic cars may take about 2 days, otherwise if forwarded to Gyumri may take much more.
