Removal Goods – Export Air and Sea

Documents Required

- Permanent visa holder / Brazilian citizen
- 1 notarized copy of Brazilian ID Card (RG) / National Foreigner Registry (RNE); (Digital copy, Guarulhos & Santos)
- 1 simple copy of CPF (Brazilian Taxpayer ID Card) or protocol / application. (Digital copy, Guarulhos & Santos)
- It must be regular with the Federal Revenue of Brazil.
- You may check it at the Federal Revenue website: www.receita.fazenda.gov.br
- 1 notarized copy of all passport pages, including cover and blank pages (for Santos & Guarulhos, simple copy is enough– only bio page notarized for Rio de Janeiro).
- 1 digital copy of airline ticket or e-ticket
- It must contain shipper's name, flight number and date, e-ticket number and airline logo.
- its validity must be less than 6 months and must have the same origin and destination of the shipment.
- 1 copy of the boarding pass
- it may be scanned
- required only for air shipment
- 2 original Powers of Attorney filled,
- signed in all pages and the last one notarized. Address must be the same as the proof of residence in Brazil.

- 2 original RFB Power of Attorneys, signed in all pages and the last one notarized.

- It must be regular with the Federal Revenue of Brazil.

- Important: its validity has to be less than 6 months and must have the same origin and destination of the shipment.

- 2 original Powers of Attorney filled, signed and notarized. Address must be the same as the proof of residence in Brazil.
- 1 original Electronic Power of Attorney.
- 2 original RFB power of attorneys, signed in all pages and the last one notarized.

- 1 original travel reason declaration, with signature notarized (Fortaleza);
- 1 original export inventory list, with signature notarized (Fortaleza, Recife).
- 1 original travel reason declaration "Motivo de Viagem", with signature notarized (Rio Grande)
- Diplomatic visa
- 1 notarized copy of the diplomatic ID card
- Notified copy of the diplomatic ID card
- 1 simple copy of CPF (Brazilian Taxpayer ID Card) or protocol / application.
- It must be regular with the Federal Revenue of Brazil.
- You may check it at the Federal Revenue website: www.receita.fazenda.gov.br
- 1 notarized copy of proof of residence in Brazil
- 1 notarized copy of airline ticket or eticket.
- It must contain shipper's name, flight number and date, e-ticket number and airline logo.
- Important: its validity must be less than 6 months and must have the same origin and destination of the shipment.
- 1 copy of the boarding pass
- It may be scanned
- Required only for air shipment
- 2 original Powers of attorney filled and signed.
- This document should be sent to MRE (Foreign Ministry) in Brasilia for notarization of signature.
- 1 original electronic Power of Attorney
- 2 original RFB power of attorneys, signed in all pages and the last one notarized.
- 3 DSE forms with additional sheets for approval of the MRE.
- Please provide the following information to prepare the DSE list: full name, nationality, social security number, diplomatic card number, passport, address in Brazil, departure date from Brazil as per air ticket.
- 1 notarized copy of passport
- Including cover and blank pages.

Remarks

- Permanent visa holders
- If the permanent visa holder has come with the move into Brazil when he had the Temporary Visa, and (s)he has signed the bond guarantee, a copy of the bond guarantee or the Protocol of the cancellation request is required.
- If the permanent visa holder has not come with the move into Brazil, or already had a permanent visa on entrance, (s)he must fill the statement of no bond guarantee "Declaração sem termo de responsabilidade" signed and notarized.
- Always stay aware about the expiry date of the visa.

- Please fill out all forms in the computer before printing.
- Temporary visa holders
- Presentation of Bond guarantee or Temporary Admission and Import list of goods (DSI)
- If you have got an extension of your visa,
- you must know whether the bond guarantee has been updated.
- If the company or the client confirms that (s)he did not bring his/her move when coming to Brazil, it is necessary to submit a statement that the client has only brought clothes, shoes and books at entrance.
- If the company has paid all import taxes, (nationalized the move), a copy of the DSI (import list of goods) is needed.
- If the temporary visa holder has not come with the move into Brazil, (s)he must fill the statement of no bond guarantee “Declaração sem termo de responsabilidade” signed and notarized.
- If the Customs officer judges that the copies presented are not in good condition or manipulated, they may require new notarized copies of the document or even the original.
- All forms and Power of Attorney to be filled out in the computer and printed just for signature and recognition.
- In case you have two shipments, sea and air, it will be required to present 2 sets of documents according to the ones listed above, totalling 2 copies of each document, plus 4 Power of Attorneys.
- For customs clearance purposes, any and all fine work, such as paintings, tapestries, statues, etc. must be duly authorized by IPHAN (Institute of National Historical and Artistic Heritage).

- To issue the international insurance, a list of goods with values in US\$ duly signed by the customer must be submitted to the moving company along with the documents required for shipping.
- That list may be made on the proper form of the insurance company or in any other format.
- This document must be provided up to 1 day prior to packing day.
- For security reason, it is not recommended to send personal electronic devices such as photo cameras, notebooks, tablets, I-pods and smart phones in sea shipments to and from Brazil.
- All the documents must be typed, including the date.

Removal Goods - Export Air for Rio de Janeiro & Guarulhos

- If the permanent visa holder has not come with the move into Brazil, or already had a permanent visa on entrance, he must fill the statement of no bond guarantee "Declaração sem termo de responsabilidade" signed and notarized".
- Always stay aware about the expiry date of the visa.

Removal Goods - Export Sea Rio de Janeiro & Sao Paulo

Documents Required

- 1 simple and legible copy of Brazilian ID Card (RG) / national Foreigner Registry (RNE) (notarized for Rio de Janeiro)
- 1 simple and legible copy of CPF (Brazilian Taxpayer ID Card) or protocol / application (notarized for Rio de Janeiro).
- It must be regular with the Federal Revenue of Brazil.
- You may check it at the Federal Revenue website: www.receita.fazenda.gov.br
- 1 notarized copy of proof of residence (Rio de Janeiro).
- 1 simple and legible copy of all passport pages, including cover and blank pages.
- 1 copy of airline ticket or e-ticket.

List of documents required for customs clearance at destination

Documents Required

- Europe
- FRANCE - Certificat de Non Cession filled and signed (for foreigners and French citizen) and Certificat de Changement de Residence issued by the French Consulate in Brazil (for French citizen).
- ENGLAND - TOR Form filled and signed. (for foreigners and English citizen) (C3 form).
- PORTUGAL - Baggage Certificate, Declaration of Residency and Consularized List of Goods issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for foreigners and Portuguese citizen).
- SPAIN - Certificate of "Baja" issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for Spanish citizen) and Certificate of residence in Brazil (for foreigners).
- ITALY - Autocertificazione and Certificato Consolare (Per L'esenzione dal payment delle imposte doganali sull'importazione in Italy delle masserizie usate) (for Italian citizens).
- North and Central America
- USA - Visa on passport and 3299 form filled and signed (for foreigners and American citizens).
- CANADA - Copy of the visa on passport (client must be in Canada at the time of Customs release of the move).
- MEXICO
- 4 copies of Consularized Detailed List of Goods (Menaje de Casa) in Spanish issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for Mexican citizens / permanent resident visa holders) and number of the RFC.
- 4 copies of Consularized Detailed List of Goods (Menaje de Casa) in Spanish issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for Visa FM2, FM3 and Mexicans). For Mexican citizens, it is required the "menaje de casa" issued by Mexican Consulate and number of the RFC (Salvador, Rio de Janeiro and Vitoria).
- South America
- ARGENTINA
- Certificate of Residence issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for Argentineans and Permanents in Argentina).
- Copy of DNI to make the Migration Certificate. It must be obtained in Argentina with maximum advance.
- There will be the payment of tax at the destination if the shipper has been in Argentina for over 60 days (total) in the last year.
- Client must be in Argentina at the time
- of Customs release of the move.
- COLOMBIA - Certificate of Residence issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for Colombians)

- VENEZUELA
- Certificate of Use and Consularized List (in Spanish) issued by the Consulate in Brazil (for Venezuelans and Permanent residents in Venezuela).
- Items shipped to Venezuela must be at least 6 months of use.
- Client must be in Venezuela at the time of Customs release of the move.
- URUGUAY - Consularized List of goods and Certificate of Residence (for Uruguayans).
- ECUADOR – Consularized List of goods and Authorization for move issued by Consulate in Brazil.
- PERU - Any refrigerating device like refrigerators, freezers, air conditioning devices, etc., must have a Certificate issued by the manufacturer stating that the coolant used in such devices does not damage the ozone layer (R134A gas) and the Technical Specification of each artifact will be mandatory; otherwise, they will be confiscated by Peruvian Customs authorities. Client must be in Peru at the time of Customs release of the move.
- Australia:
- AUSTRALIA – B534 Form filled and signed (for Foreigners and Australians).

Forbidden Items

Customs Prescriptions

- Firearms, replicas and imitations, ammunition, machete
- Swords
- Allowed only for militaries.
- Airplanes
- Drones and aeroplanes
- Alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages
- Gas grills or propane tanks
- Allowed: grill without the tank.
- Car parts such as wheels, tires and seats
- Car accessories
- Allows GPS, sound equipment and speaker.
- Cleaning products and other consumer goods related
- Collections with high value
- Coins
- Stamps
- Jewelry
- Lithium battery, lithium-ion and metal batteries or cells
- Medicines
- Medical equipment
- Food
- Corrosives
- Acids
- Drain Cleaners
- Photographic acids used in developing film
- Iron or steel rust preventing compounds
- Bleach
- Batteries (wet or dry)
- Water purifying agents such as those commonly used in swimming pools
- Explosives
- Fireworks
- Arms ammunition
- Flash Bulbs

- Large power tools
- Compressed Gases
- Aerosol cans
- Fire extinguishers
- Scuba diving tanks
- Hot tubs, Jacuzzis, spas
- Flammables
- Lighter fluids
