Ecuadorian or foreign citizens (non-diplomats)

Documents Required

- Notarized color copy of passport (photo page and last visa).
- Letter to the Assistant District Manager of Customs
- Original signed migratory movement.
- Packing list.
- Standard of Conduct for CONTECON.

Foreign or national diplomats

Documents Required

- Notarized color copy of passport (photo page and last visa).
- Letter to the Deputy District Customs Manager.
- Letter to the Anti-Narcotics Police - issued by the Consulate and/or Embassy.
- Packing List. Standard of Conduct for CONTECON.

Private vehicle

Documents Required

- Copy of the last registration of the vehicle, notarized.
- Notarized bill of sale or notarized purchase contract.
- Certificate of Bad Debt
- Simple copy of all the documents with which the car entered Ecuador.

Diplomatic vehicle

Documents Required

- Copy of the last registration of the vehicle, notarized.
- Notarized bill of sale or notarized purchase contract.
- Authorization of exit of the vehicle, from the Chancellery.
- Simple copy of all the documents with which the car entered Ecuador.
- Letter to the Assistant District Manager of Customs.
- Letter to the Anti-Narcotics Police -issued by the Consulate and/or Embassy.
- Standard of Conduct for CONTECON.
