Household goods

Documents Required

- For Spanish citizens and foreign citizens:
- Passport copy
- DNI or NIE copy
- Valued inventory list in Spanish, valued and signed by the customer
- Set of forms duly signed

Remarks

- NIE number is obtained when applying for a work/residence permit. NIE number must be registered at AEAT database (Spanish treasure department).
- The customs forms are provided by the local agent in Spain.
- All documents must be available before packing.
- As from 1 January 2024, a tax on plastic used is due. The applicable tax is due on non-recycled plastic contained in the taxed products.

Diplomats' removals

Documents Required

- Copy of diplomatic NIE (diplomatic ID)
- Copy of diplomatic Passport
- Inventory list signed by owner
- Set of forms duly signed

Used motor vehicles and motorcycles

Documents Required

- For Spanish citizens and foreign citizens:
- Photocopy of passport
- DNI or NIE copy
- De-registration copy ("Baja de Tráfico")
- Car/motorcycle's purchase invoice duly signed
- Set of forms
- Vehicle registration ("Permiso de Circulación")
- Technical datasheet ("Ficha Técnica")
- For diplomats:
- Photocopy of passport.
- Copy of diplomatic NIE (diplomatic ID)
- Embassy letter requesting the Deregistration

- De-registration copy ("Baja de Tráfico")
- Set of forms

Remarks

- For new vehicles the invoice has to be issued with the foreign address of the customer and without VAT
- De-registration is issued by Spanish traffic department.
- For diplomatic vehicles will be necessary the embassy letter and the approval of the deregistration.
- The customs forms are provided by the local agent in Spain.
- All documents must be available before the
