

# NORWAY

## Used household goods and personal effects

### Documents Required

- Inventory list.
- Copy of passport (photo page).
- Norwegian ID number (11 digits).
- Export declaration.

### Remarks

- Consider if a temporary export declaration is relevant, in order to prepare for an early return to Norway.

## Weapons, -parts and ammunition

### Documents Required

- Proof of ownership.
- If it is a permanent export, export permit from the local police is required.

## Object of cultural heritage and artworks

### Documents Required

- Export permit is required.
- Application for export need to be sent to Ministry of Culture and Equality: <https://www.regjeringen.no/en/dep/kud/id545/>

## Used vehicles

### Documents Required

- Registration card / title and proof of origin (EUR 1 or origin declaration)

### Customs Prescriptions

- If exporter is other than importer:
- You must present a supplier's declaration from the importer. Norwegian Customs may

demand to undertake the necessary investigations concerning the product's origin status before EUR 1 is endorsed. You are not entitled to have EUR 1 endorsed at the time of export if Norwegian Customs wishes to undertake such investigation.

- If the vehicle in question was imported more than 10 years ago, a supplier's declaration or other sufficient documentation is acceptable.
