Removal Goods and Vehicles

Documents Required

- Copy of client's passport and visa page to be provided to the destination agent
- Copy of inventory / PBO list if the goods are packed by the client
- Destination country customs forms / documents
- Alcohol listing / inventory
- Electronic items profile
- Service acceptance contract including clients contact details
- Insurance documents
- Any other documentation required by the destination agent.
- If shipping a vehicle:
 - Vehicle registration / ownership documents
 - Vehicle purchase invoice
 - Vehicle Odometer reading
- Client's declaration if the vehicle can be shipped DG / NON-DG with authorisation for disconnection of battery and draining the fuel etc.

Customs Prescriptions

- Batteries for e-bikes, e-scooters hoverboards are prohibited for export
- Acceptance of batteries are subject to carrier and port acceptance and not guaranteed
- No export of Electric Vehicles

Remarks

- There are no particular export clearance requirements for used household goods and vehicles in New Zealand except that the client is required to provide the listed documents.
