Household Goods - Diplomats

Documents Required

- Client's copy passport.

Remarks

- No restrictions on any items, unless they are clearly illegal.
- Very limited amounts for non-diplomatic shipments as in less than 10 bottles. They would need to present MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) for each bottle. If they have a tax-free exemption then no tax or duty on the alcohol, otherwise they will pay high taxes.
- Restricted Items for air shipment
- Any types of liquids
- refrigerators or any appliance with freon/compressor
- medications & vitamins,
- any types of magnets
- any item with alcohol content,
- sprays and aerosols,
- pressurized glass bottles
- any type of battery
- shells, seeds,
- highly flammable material (lighters, butane re-fillers, safety
- matches, etc.),
- knives,
- wires & cables,
- electrical tapes,
- fuse,
- CD's / DVD's
- cassette tapes (any components of Optical Tape)
- animal by-products
- tobacco products
