Household goods & personal effect – private person

Documents Required

- Power of attorney authorizing the moving company to represent the exporter
- Inventory list with goods value
- Copy of passport
- Copy of Polish ID (for Polish citizenship)
- Copy of the EU 'CITIZEN' card (for EU citizenship)
- Copy of car registration

Remarks

- Without these documents, shipment cannot be released. This is valid for all nationalities.

Diplomatic shipments

Documents Required

- Power of attorney authorizing the moving company to represent the exporter (stamped by the Embassy)
- Inventory list with goods value (stamped by the Embassy)
- Copy of passport (stamped by the Embassy)
- Diplomatic ID Card (stamped by the Embassy)
- Customs request (stamped by the Embassy)
- Copy of car registration (stamped by the Embassy)
